




Event 2: 9th April, 2020.







ABOUT THOSE BIG DREAMS LOGO LAUNCH

*Lower level - The red colour is the starting level, where we should choose a goal and have a proper idea of what we need to do in order to achieve it.


*Next level indicates how to start.

We ATBD team are helping the students by organizing sessions with industry people and alumni of Stanley to share their experiences, that'll give the students an idea about how to start.


*Then, the next level indicates that we should start working on it.


