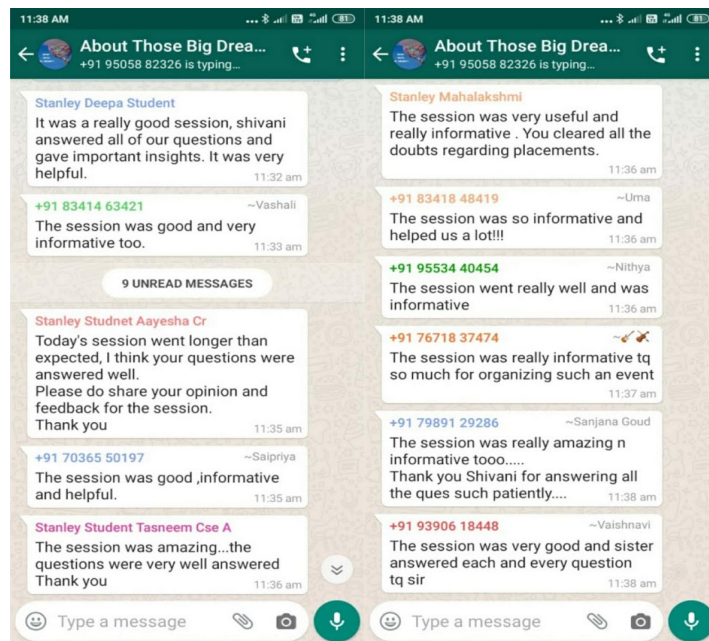
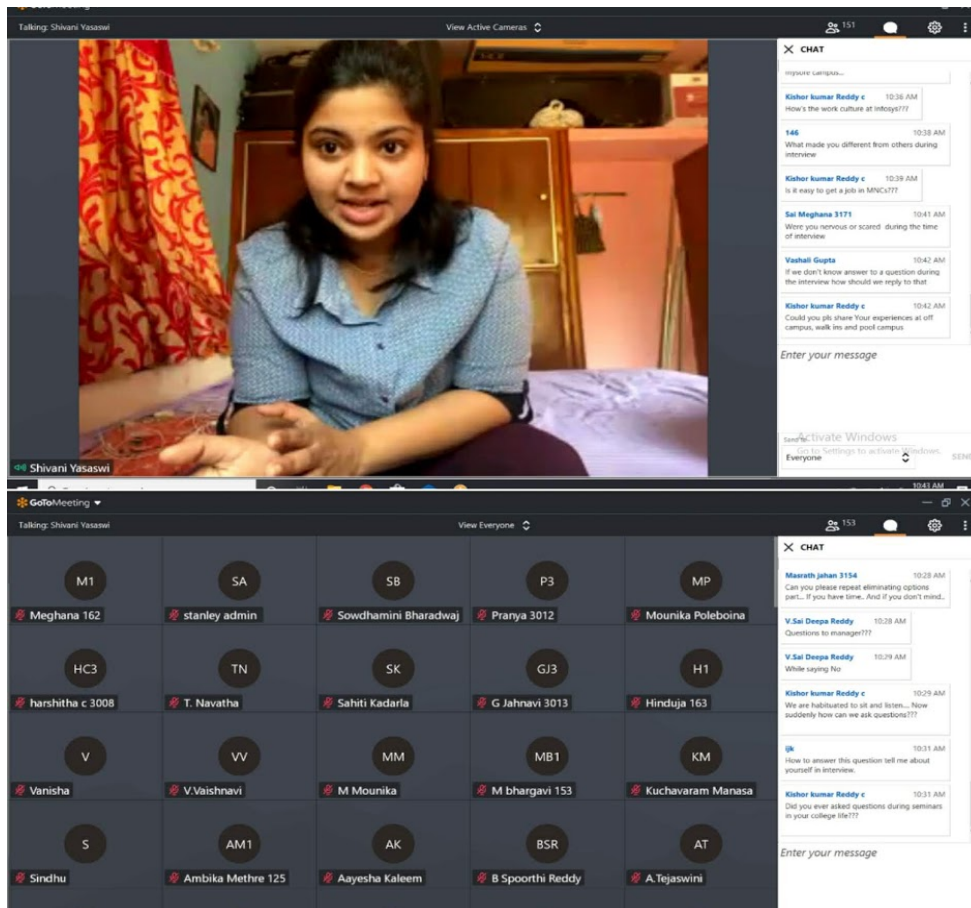




**Event 4:** 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2020.

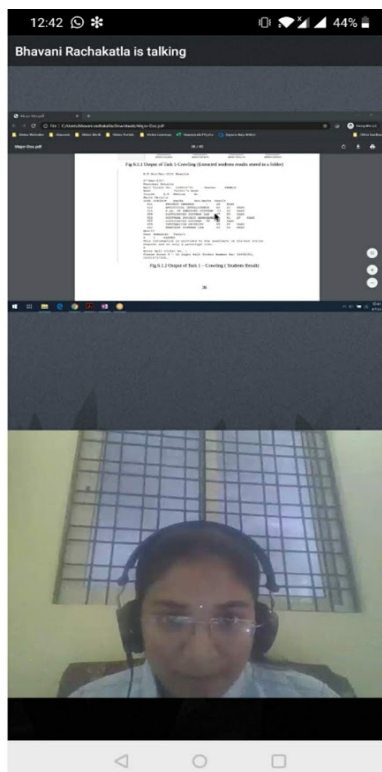
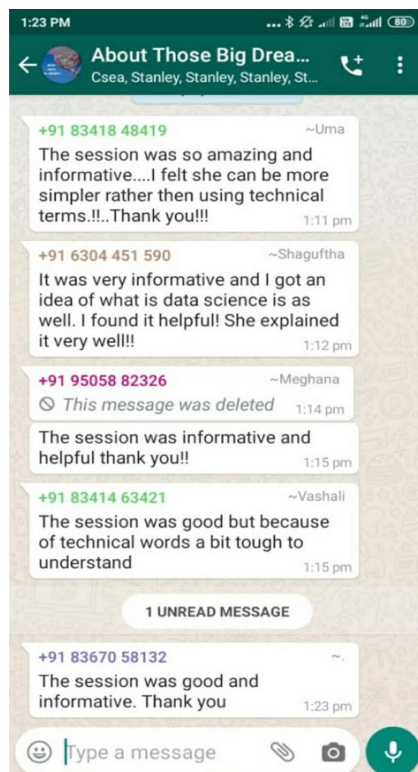
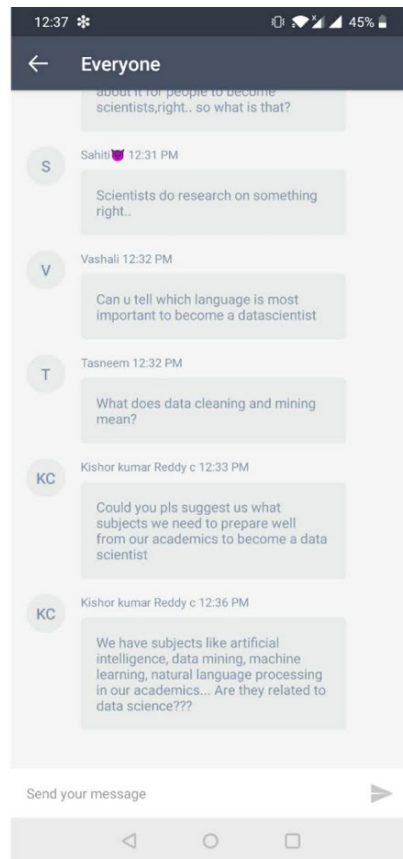
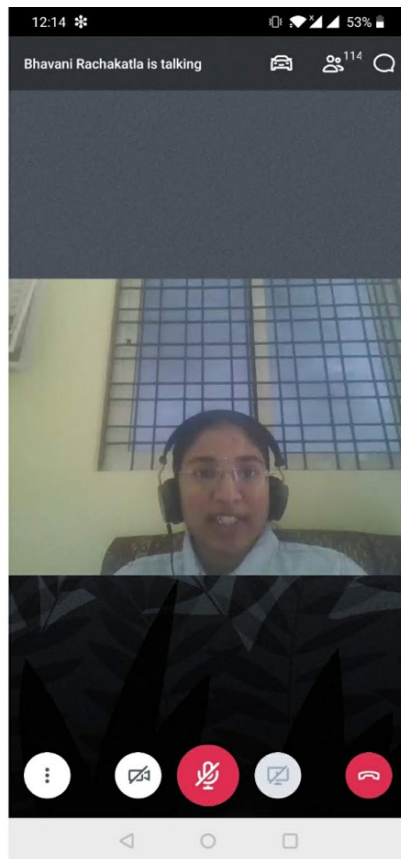


**Event 5: 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2020.**

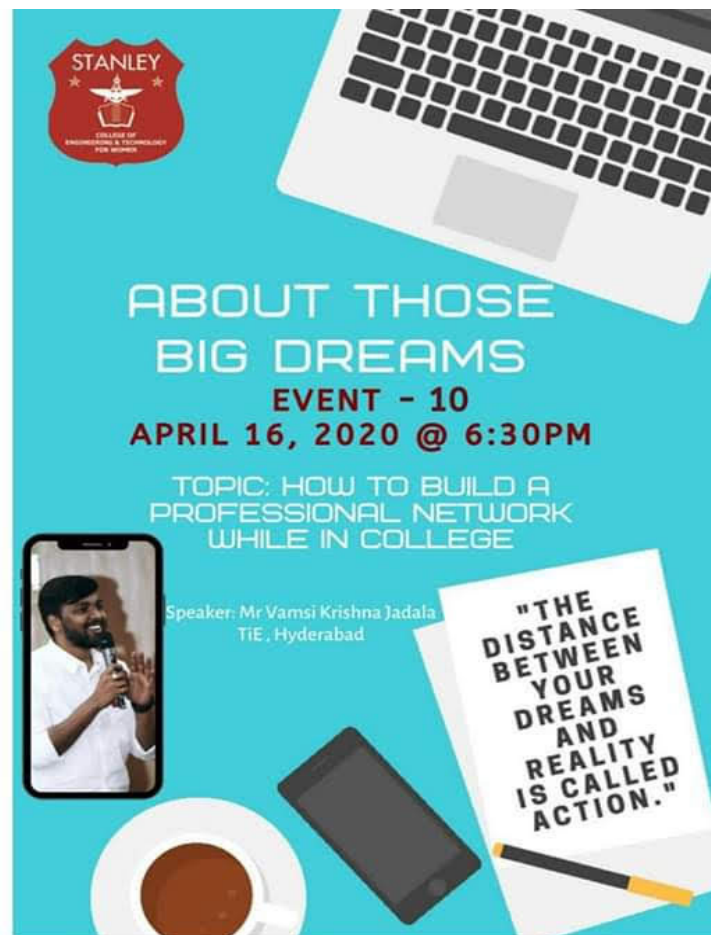
**Event 9:** 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2020.

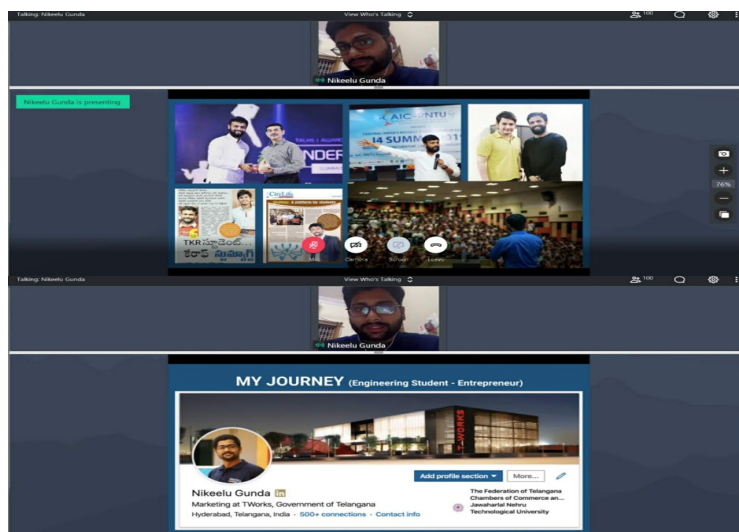
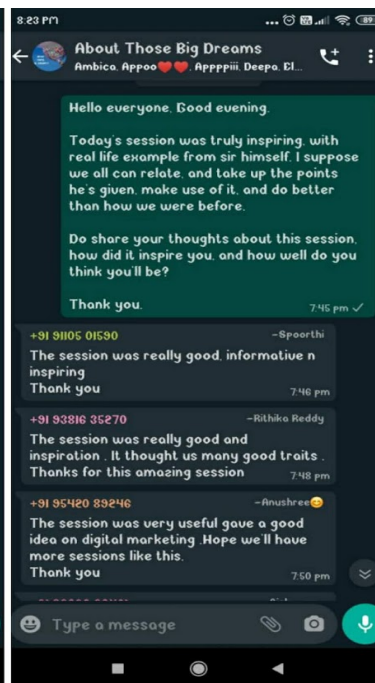
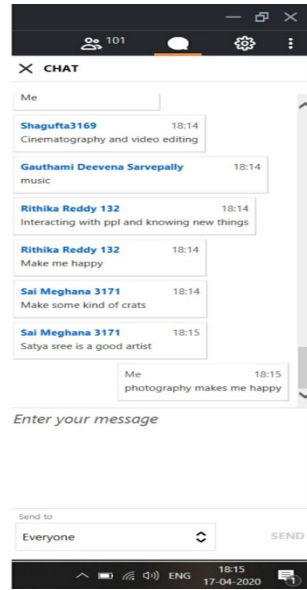
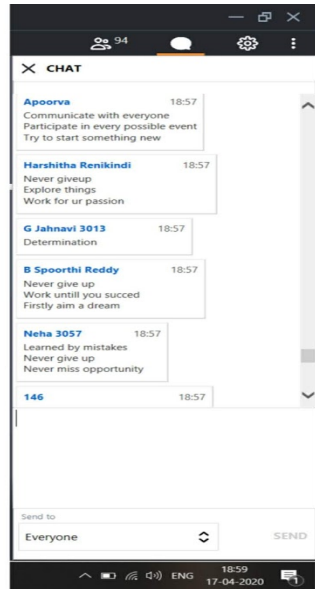


**Event 11: 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2020.**

\*Lower level - The red colour is the starting level, where we should choose a goal and have a proper idea of what we need to do in order to achieve it.

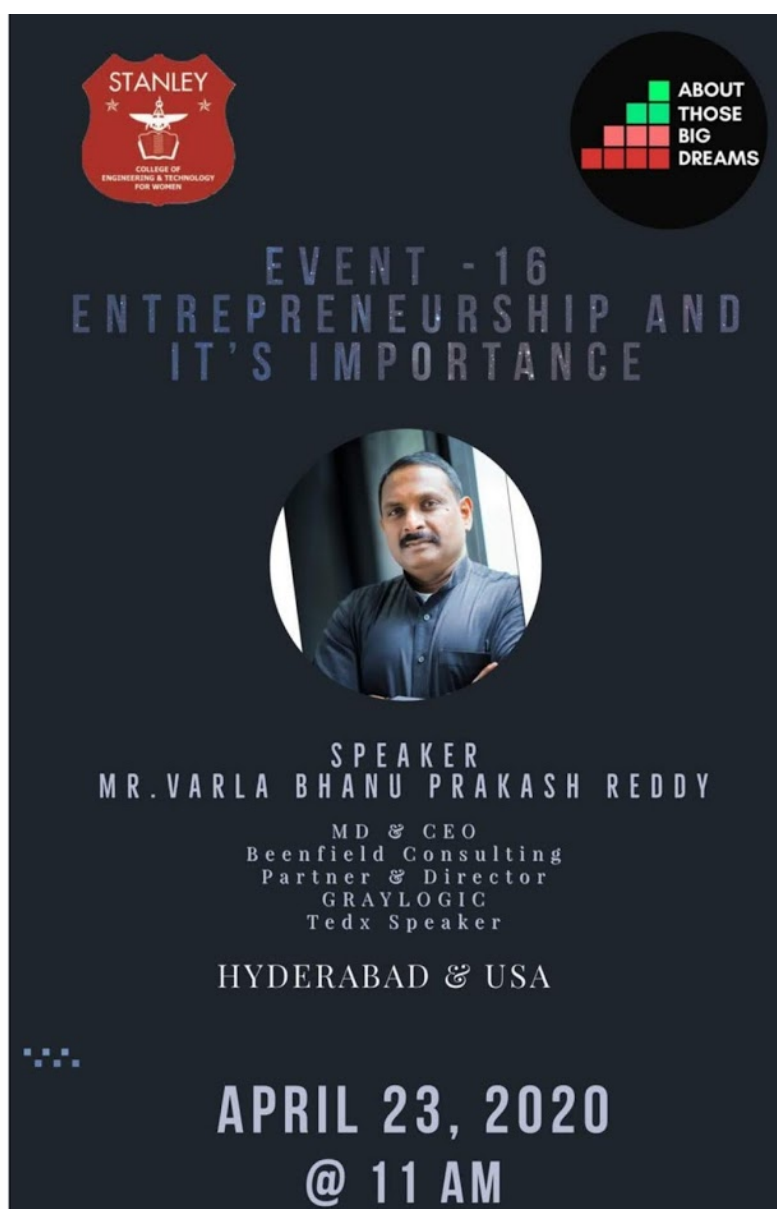
\*Next level indicates how to start.
